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STRATEGIC OBJETIVES

- To increase our visibility as a research group, increasing the number and quality of projects. To enhance close collaboration with the European Society of Anaesthesia and Intensive Care (ESAIC) and the World Federation of Societies of Anaesthesiologists (WFSA), having also collaborative projects at national level working together within the framework of the Spanish Society of Anaesthesia and Resuscitation (SEDAR).
- To strengthen our collaboration with other research groups led by our senior colleagues, obstetricians, paediatricians, other surgeons and research groups of nurses and midwives. Encourage young researchers to initiate PhD projects in an established research area.
